



The Leiter Clinic at Southern Yacht Club in New Orleans is aimed at improving the competitive sailing skills of junior women sailors planning to compete at the regional and national levels. The clinic will be held from **Noon on Friday, April 28 through 3 pm on Sunday, April 30, 2017**. Funding for the clinic is provided by a grant from Judy and Stephanie McLennan, daughter and granddaughter of Nancy Leiter Clagett after whom the Leiter Cup is named.

The clinic is open to girls who will not age out during the 2017 sailing year, meaning that the girl cannot turn 19 during 2017.

As there are a limited number of spots available in the clinic, selection will be based on demonstrated enthusiasm and participation in sailing activities. The boats sailed in this clinic are the Laser Radial and the Club 420.

There is no fee for the clinic, yet participants must provide their own transportation to and from New Orleans. **Laser sailors must bring their own sails, blades and lines.** 420 crew sailors should bring a trap harness. Participants will be transported to and from the airport by club volunteers. Housing will be provided Friday and Saturday nights. A refundable deposit in the amount of \$250.00 is due with each application. The deposit check will be returned after the clinic if there is no boat damage and the sailor attends the clinic.
